Project GATWICK

You will recollect that we have planned for David Creighton to examine the GATWICK cigarettes in order to see if he could make any observations on the behaviour of smokers taking up these cigarettes. I imagine your programme of work is almost at the point where you could let us have samples and we could start our test programme.

We would like you to let us have about 20,000 JPS cigarettes or Du MAURIER for use in accustoming our subjects to Canadian cigarettes. In addition, we shall require 400 GATWICK cigarettes and 400 control cigarettes, for the tests themselves. Could you confirm whether you are yet in a position to supply these? I will then arrange with Mr. Smeed to confirm the shipping and Customs arrangements to you before they are consigned.
