Dear Jack,

During my absence abroad recently, there was an interchange of correspondence between Leo Lavorte and Sir Charles Ellis concerning various aspects of smoke analysis. Sir Charles suggests, and it is a suggestion which has our fullest support, that there should be a full exchange of information concerning the work on "smoke" carried out in the Laboratories of our respective Companies. If your Company is agreeable that this should be done, I will ask Anderson to send to Lavorte his current "Smoke Programme" and also to sketch out the ideas that lie behind it and where it has got to at present. Apart, however, from reports it is envisaged that there may be direct laboratory to laboratory correspondence on current matters before they have reached the report stage. I feel that such a pooling of our work on smoke, and its various health aspects, would be to our mutual advantage and interest and I therefore hope that your Company may feel able to agree with this proposal.
