Dear Jim,

On June 2nd, Mr. Laporte sent to you a copy of a memorandum dated May 25th and prepared by myself on Endrin.

Last week we received a copy of a memorandum prepared by Dr. E.R. Houghton of the Plant Products Division, Canada Department of Agriculture, giving his observations on the meeting at Delhi and clarifying the figures on possible levels of intake of Endrin from smoking cigarettes. While the intermediate calculations are somewhat different from those presented at the meeting, the final result is the same. I am enclosing a copy of this memorandum as I think you will find it of interest and you may wish to send it on to others in the organization as you have with my original memorandum. I think, however, this memorandum ought to be considered confidential within the organization.

I received a letter from Jeremy Wood yesterday in which he requested some additional information concerning levels of Endrin in the tobacco and cigarette smoke which I am sending him directly, together with a copy of Houghton's report. Jeremy queried whether the Threshold Limit Value for DDT shown as 0.1 mg/m³ in my report should not read 1.0 mg/m³. Houghton's memorandum shows that it should be 1.0 mg/m³ and we would appreciate if you could bring this error to the attention of the people to whom you sent my original memorandum.
