Action Taken: By standard letter agreement dated July 26, 1971, B&W agreed to receive for its inspection and consideration a one-pound sample of tobacco treated with the formula so as to effect maximum "tar" and nicotine removal. In early August, 1971, the developers of the formula returned a fully executed copy of the July 26 letter agreement and, under separate cover, forwarded a sample of BUGLER Smoking Tobacco which was reportedly treated with the formula. This sample was evaluated by B&W Research and, by memo dated November 30, 1971, B&W Law was advised that no further action should be taken with regard to this development. On December 1, 1971, B&W Law wrote the submitter and advised her that B&W has no present interest in the development.
