

Extract of note prepared by A. Heard for TSRT on  
10th November 1989

On the basis of allocation of costs to CAC companies agreed previously (and incorporating the previous contribution by Amatil into the BATCo element) the individual costs for CACs in 1990 would be (1989 figures agreed at the March meeting of TSRT are shown in brackets):

BATCo	32%	x	£3.98	=	£1.27	(£1.11)
B&W	30%	x	"	=	£1.19	(£1.04)
ITL	19%	x	"	=	£0.76	(£0.66)
BATCF	19%	x	"	=	£0.76	(£0.66)

Additionally, funding for the Scientific Research Group projects (external projects in the area of smoking issues) has previously been agreed at this meeting. The proposed SRG budget for 1990 is £344,000 (cf £330,000 in 1989). In this case the costs are normally shared on an equal contributions basis by the CACs. In view of the reduction of contributors to four, the proposed SRG contribution for each CAC country is £86,000 (cf £66,000 in 1989).
