Stewart Massey has passed on to me the State Express "555" analysis report and obtained confirmation that "555" has recently been launched in Canada.

In order to meet the Tobacco Products Control Regulations set forth by the Canadian government and include the "555" data in our submission to Health & Welfare Canada, I unfortunately have to ask for information which is somewhat different than which you have provided.

For each batch code, I would need individual port data for PMWNF, nicotine, carbon monoxide and puff number. This would enable me to do the appropriate calculations and provide to Health and Welfare the information in the format which has been specified (i.e. statistics based on a minimum of twenty ports each quarter or data from a previous quarter where production was limited). If more detailed tobacco weight data are available, these would also be helpful.

I hope that these requirements will not cause too many difficulties. If you need any clarification, please let me know.
