Project Title: Evaluation of Buckingham King Size Plain
Cigarettes using different cigarette papers.
Object: To reduce the levels of DPM to less than 22 mg.
Personnel Involved: R.R. Smith

2nd Half 1971: Three Schweitzer cigarette papers of intermediate porosity containing phosphate additives and three containing citrate were used to try and reach this objective. Three papers were successful in reducing yields, i.e. 24 and 30 greiner second citrate and 22 greiner sec phosphate papers. This project was also done in conjunction with a similar request for Pall Mall K.S. Plain (see T-1520). Since only the 24 greiner sec citrate was suitable for the latter blend and for reasons of economy in cigarette paper inventory this paper was recommended for use also on Buckingham K.S. Plain. The change was implemented in January 1972.
