Object: To reduce the levels of DPM to less than 22 mg.

2nd Half 1971: For the purpose of reducing DPM yields, a total of six papers of varying mid-range porosities were used on Pall Mall blend. Three contained phosphate and three others citrate additives. Only one of the six was successful in reducing DPM yields, this was the 24 greiner sec citrate paper. A recommendation to change was adopted in January 1972.
