PRT from 1971 Canadian Crop Samples

Graham Roswall has asked me to reply to your letter of August 31st, as he will be out of town for a while. We agree that it would be better to ship the samples in smaller batches as you suggest. After discussing the shipping with our Traffic and Customs & Excise Departments, we feel the best route would be by sea (presumably Atlantic Container Lines from Southampton to Halifax to Montreal, which, I believe, is fast when there are no strikes). I feel sure that Millbank will be able to supply the required forms, if they are not available in GRDC. These forms (MR invoices) have to show the fair market value in U.K., but should also be marked no commercial value, in the appropriate columns. The address for shipping is Imperial Tobacco Products Ltd, 3810 St-Antoine St, Montreal, Quebec. The samples should be marked to my attention.

We would appreciate receiving samples of 100% PRT cigarettes in the more interesting cases, so we can parallel your NIF and in-house biological tests with our own biochemical assays.
