I enclose copies of methods for Acrolein and nitric oxide in smoke as promised at the last C.S.C. meeting. I think they are now in a form ready for inclusion into RP11. You will see that the method for Acrolein contains 3 figures. The chromatogram would be best included with the text but the other two figures I have labelled 11a and 11b since they can be entered at the back of the book in place of the existing figures relating to the current acrolein method.
