U. K. Directing Committee

Role of R. & D.

In general the R. & D. role is to give the R. & D. view whenever it is pertinent. More specifically, this entails:-

- (1) The recognition of those situations where the Committee requires expertise uniquely available from R. & D.
- (2) The identification of particular individual skills, within R. & D., which may be required by the Committee.
- (3) Advising the Committee on developments in the smoking and health field which are relevant to operations in the United Kingdom.
- (4) Providing technical input on matters relating to the product, notably on filters, papers, additives, and alternatives to leaf tobacco.
