In answer to your request for updated information on smoking parameters used, throughout the world, I am attaching a copy of a "CORESTA Smoke Study Group Survey of International Practice Regarding Standard Butt Lengths Employed in Analytical Smoking Tests, December 1st, 1973". This survey does not indicate how smoke condensate deliveries are expressed or if there is any form of publication of smoke analysis results in the various countries.

I am also enclosing a copy of a note, which has been prepared by our Public Relations Department. The copies of articles which are indicated as "attached" can be forwarded if you require them, but they do not contain information regarding smoking parameters employed.
