With reference to our discussion at the Ventilation Conference last October, please be informed that I will be the person to contact for exchange of information and queries regarding the production aspect of ventilated cigarettes.


Since our last meeting, the only point of interest to report is that we have opted for wipe skip tip versus 1:1 gluing technique at 5,000 c.p.m. on Mark 9/Max S for regular production of ventilated cigarettes.

Our decision was based on equal ventilation results for both techniques coupled with a preference for the principle of wipe skip tipping for better bonding. Unfortunately, this decision had to be taken with limited running at 5,000 c.p.m.

I would appreciate any comments you may have running at 5,000 c.p.m. with either of these gluing techniques.
