Dear Tom,

Just to confirm the telephone conversation that, at its next meeting, the AGP will record its absence of objections to the use of Aquapel 360XC applied to cigarette paper as a surface size or varnish at a concentration of 1%.

The restriction in relation to surface application is proposed because of the recommendation of Haroules to use Kymene also if added to the stock.

The AGP remains unable to recommend the use of Haroon 40 as an additive to cigarette paper.

The acceptance of Aquapel 360XC will be conditional upon the demonstration that cigarettes using treated paper do not differ significantly in deliveries such as of unsaturated carbonyl compounds. We would be able to undertake the latter smoke analysis for you - 100 cigarettes each in control and treated paper would be adequate and it would also be of interest to us to see a sample of the papers, e.g. part of a bobbin, if available.

A label and consigning instructions to be followed in sending the cigarettes are enclosed.
