
This is to confirm information you will already have seen that the AGP accepted the use of Industrial Adhesives (Canada) formulation RO760 as a cigarette side-seam adhesive.

I understand that this formulation is a replacement for one identified as RO716. One ingredient in the initial submission of RO760 was regarded as undesirable by the Panel. Approval is for the revised formulation, but with the same identification.

You recall the Leaf Steering Committee suggesting that the people at Aylmer might like to see the cigarettes made from the Cylproc trial (1981). I have at last organized a pack of each type that was made and am sending them to you under separate cover, just for their interest.
