Dear Lionel:

Dr. Mino Bilimoria will be presenting a paper at a poster session during the Second International Congress on Toxicology being held in Brussels July 7 - 11. The title is "Influence of Tobacco Smoke on Tissue Enzyme Induction and Conversion of Pro-mutagens in the Ames System" and covers work which he has carried out at McGill University under sponsorship by the Canadian Tobacco Manufacturers Council. If it is acceptable we would like Mino to visit the Hamburg and Southampton laboratories following the congress.

Because of the nature of his work and because of the investigation in GR & DC of the use of an in vitro radio-chemical mammalian DNA binding assay involving the use of microsomal preparations as a predictive carcinogenicity test, we feel it would be very beneficial for him to again spend a short time in both Southampton and Hamburg.

If acceptable we would propose the following itinerary and because of heavy summer Trans-Atlantic traffic, we have already booked flights.

- July 7 - 11 - Toxicology Congress, Brussels.
- July 13 - Arrive Hamburg 19:45 Lufthansa Flight 109Y.
- July 14 & 15 - B.A.T. laboratories, Hamburg.
- July 15 - Leave Hamburg 17:15 Lufthansa Flight 042Y.
Arrive London 17:50 " " "
Travel in evening to Southampton.
- July 16 - 17 - GR & DC
- July 18 - GR & DC and return to London for a personal visit.


