Dear Derek,

I have this morning received a Telex from Mr. R.S. Wade of Imperial Tobacco, Canada, which reads as follows:

"E.P.A. gave conditional approval this morning to use of Ridomil for control of Blue Mould and Black Shank to be applied to soil at rate of 1 lb. per acre. Some Ridomil will be available in all tobacco growing States but quantities are uncertain."

I am seeking clarification of what precisely is meant by "conditional", but in the meantime you may like to pass on the information to other A.C.S.C. members.
