However, it has had a dual use in that there is the suggestion that the chloride content of the tobacco may also be implicated. This observation will be taken into account in our study of factors influencing aromatic polycyclic hydrocarbon production.

I think it might be useful for Mr. Davies (S.C.L.) to see this report, since if it is intended to restart temperature measurements at S.C.L. at any time we might get together to discuss possible reasons for the divergence between our results.
