A STATISTICAL ANALYSIS OF THE INCIDENCE OF TUMOUR-BEARING
ANIMALS IN JANUS EXPERIMENT B1
REPORT NO. RD.954-R

The primary purpose of this report is to present the statistical analysis of the incidence of tumour bearing animals in a form suitable for incorporation by Battelle into the full report on the B1 experiment which they will issue.

The tables of pathological data have only been included in this report for completeness, and have not been analysed since this is the responsibility of Battelle.

It is proposed to use the same circulation as that employed in the case of RD.855-R (JANUS B0), namely, three copies for yourself plus two copies for Dr. Felton - one of which Dr. Evelyn will pass to Battelle. Dr. Evelyn has, of course, seen this report prior to issue.
