We are examining currently a number of commercial brands of cigarettes (~~job number 40~~) which contain large amounts of indigenous tobacco. The aim is to increase our knowledge of the effects of different types of tobacco on the composition and biological activity of smoke.

One of these brands is the cigarette Gallia, about which there has been considerable press comment along the lines of a "safer" cigarette. According to Campbell-Johnson Ltd., Gallia will be on sale throughout France from 15th September onwards.

In view of the interest in this cigarette, we have produced a report specifically on Gallia and the report is now ready for distribution. Our work on the other brands will be reported separately.

If the information is to be passed to TRC, then I think it will be necessary to produce an "A-version" of the report.
