AIR MAIL BLEND

We are pleased to receive your letter of May 24th following up Minute 10 of the ... Conference; however, as you are well aware, our main interest in ... is that Southampton continue to work with the ... tobaccos since the blended market in Canada is very small. We would nevertheless be most happy with the choice of a blend of U.S. burley grades from the upper part of the plant since our Canadian burley is not that dissimilar from the American burley and also because we have occasional ideas about the possibility of incorporating some Canadian burley into specific five-cured cigarette recipes.

We are also in agreement that it would be better to use one type of tobacco solely for R & D's purpose rather than a blend including considerable five-cured tobacco.

We are therefore in complete agreement with the suggestions set forth in your letter.
