Dear Leo,

Because of our recent postal strike I had to leave the detailed arrangements for my forthcoming trip to the USA to Wally. I do not think I can do better than to enclose a photocopy of a recent letter from him outlining the itinerary he has planned and which gives full details for the first three weeks. I was not planning to visit Canada on this occasion, especially as the US trip is pretty long and covers a lot of ground, mostly in connection with smoke inhalation research.
