Effect of Nitrogen Nutrition on
Smoke Composition

When this subject was discussed at the St. Ives Conference, it was agreed that delegates would endeavour to find out what investigations, if any, had already been undertaken in their own territories to relate fertilizer nitrogen dosage with smoke composition.

I believe you mentioned some work on these lines at Delhi by Elliott, but I am unable to trace any published findings. I should therefore be most grateful for any information you can obtain concerning work at Delhi, or elsewhere, on either flue-cured or burley tobacco.
