Dear Mr. Anderson,

I enclose File Note No. 0330 describing what Todd had to tell me about the meeting he recently had in Paris on the Neukomm-Bonnet process with Waltz and Weber. You will see from this that Waltz did not wish Todd to disclose the conversations to me but that, nevertheless, he did so. In view of my impending visit to Switzerland, I thought it best to put on record, on a private and confidential basis, the substance of the conversation because this gives an indication of the way Waltz is thinking.

I hope to telephone you on Friday morning (tomorrow) to learn from you the attitude I should adopt during the discussions in Switzerland, and I hope that the enclosed note is helpful from this point of view.

As you are seeing Todd on Friday afternoon, I think it may be as well not to refer to this matter in conversation with him. Although he probably guessed that I would pass the gist of it on, perhaps he should not know officially that I have done so! I think that you will appreciate my position in this.
