RADIOACTIVITY IN TOBACCO AND SMOKE

I have read the reports of T. M. S. C. on this subject and Sir Charles has briefly mentioned to me the position with regard to Mayneord.

During my recent visit I found both Wade and Laporte very anxious for news on this subject, and I had a first idea that I could cover the position by sending copies of Dr. Hughes' note of the 14th February regarding his visit to Sutton. On re-reading it, however, I find it does not summarize the position as it now stands clearly enough, particularly with regard to the point about local concentration in the lungs. Could you please prepare an Intelligence Letter for me which would give enough information to bring each member of the Group up to date. I enclose a copy of Hughes' memo to save you looking it up, and you will see what I mean. It would be useful if the note for which I am asking could also deal with the Marsden problem.
