PCL SAMPLE FOR JANUS

Your letter of December 16 arrived just a little too late for us to comply with your request to ship 200 lbs. of your PCL air freight. Actually, the full shipment of four hogsheads (2,400 lbs.) is leaving Montreal for St. John, New Brunswick today, and then via the freighter, Medicine Hat, sailing December 30 directly to Southampton, addressed as indicated in your letter of October 5. In view of this, it seems to me you should receive the 2,400 lbs. by about January 12, 1967 which, I hope, may not prove to be too late for you to carry out a toxicity test prior to considering its substitution for the Airferm tobacco.

Cort Brown will be sending you, via air mail, within the next couple of days, the necessary bills of lading and invoices.
