

Thank you for your letter of 14th December with the information that, at the moment, there is no stock of the above cigarettes. If Reemtsma manufacture more of these, as seems possible, then we would be very grateful for your help in getting 2000 cigarettes of each.

I am glad to know that you will have 2000 cigarettes of Blend E and of the three Folie B Gerlach materials at the middle of the month (December?). I think we would be very pleased to have the opportunity to examine these, too. We have to fit these samples into a schedule of experiments, however, and it may be a month or so before we are able to do this. In the meantime, could you please hold them available for us and I will get in touch with you nearer the time regarding their shipment.

Thank you for your letter of December 15th from which we were very pleased to learn that the JANUS PCL sample has been produced and is scheduled for shipment at the end of December.

Thank you also for the sample of PCL taken during the processing, which we have examined with interest. We would agree that the sheet is a higher gel type product than your normal product, but Peter Nicholl wonders whether this is purely a function of the different lamina employed rather than binder temperature at the mixing stage. We all believe, however, that it is a most satisfactory product and we look forward to receiving the bulk of the sample.

Thank you also for the details of processing conditions which you sent, which will complete the records on this experiment.

We note that you are retaining the balance of VS at Ajax for the time being, as we requested.
