To confirm our recent conversations:

1. Cigarette paper

To meet our future requirements for 'large scale' samples, please would you arrange to hold in reserve a supply of the paper which was used for Cigarette B0.

2. Further supply of CN102 lamina

Please would you arrange for the Branch to hold in reserve for us approximately 7,000 lbs of CN102 lamina (i.e. "one operation minus stem").

This is to meet possible future demands for JANUS samples.

3. Filter-tipped cigarettes

The aim is to produce three samples of filter-tipped cigarettes differing only in the filter plug used i.e. paper, acetate and bonded carbon.

Overall length of cigarettes:	85 mm
Tobacco section :	70 x 25 mm
Tobacco :	"B0 rag" ex the 1,400 lbs held in reserve
Cigarette paper etc. :	As Cigarette B0
Filter plugs :	H.G. Hornewell will arrange the supply of filter rods.

We would like to can 3,000 selected cigarettes of each type and consequently suggest that a minimum of 5,000 cigarettes are made in each case.

These cigarettes are for Project JANUS and consequently liaison with H.M. Customs is required. All costs will be booked to Project JANUS.
