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Samples for Project JANUS

As you will gather from another letter, we can begin work on the JANUS samples whenever we wish.

At the moment, we are still awaiting:

1. A code "B" die
2. Tins for packing the cigarettes
3. Details of the blend and dimensions to be used

The T.R.C. T1 and T4 cigarettes are 70 mm. x 25.3 mm. circumference. Should we follow these or would it be preferable to stick to B-A.T. dimensions of 70 mm. x 25.6 mm. circumference, or 70 mm. x 25 mm.?

At the last meeting, we agreed not to return CRS to the blend, but it was left that you would establish with Leaf Department whether the grades used in CN102 blend correspond at all closely to the flue-cured portion of VICEROY blend in Louisville.

Could you please let me know your conclusions on these two points, so that the manufacturing arrangements can be made with Southampton Branch. We can then start as soon as the outstanding engineering and packing items are received.
