Key Issues Council

15. Mr Chalfen reported that the Key Issues Council met for the first time in early November. It identified eight issues for which a Group-wide shared coherent vision would be developed within the next two months. Draft position statements and action points will be recommended to the TSG in February 1995. Mr Herter asked the TSG members to support their own staff in the development of this work, providing more resource if necessary.

5. **Additives Register:** Mr Sandefur tabled a paper proposing that every TSG company would send a list of the names of the ingredients used in its manufacture of cigarettes to a London law firm. They would be used for discussions by designated senior scientists in every other TSG company. The designated scientists would sign confidentiality agreements. If a question arose about additive usage, they would confer and exchange scientific and, with the advice of counsel, regulatory information and views. The proposal was agreed.

42. Mr Mitchell in BATCo maintains a personal confidential file on Group additives from which he can answer government queries about whether an additive is present in a brand. This file does not contain full B&W information. Mr Sandefur would be happy for Mr Mitchell to have the same information that B&W gives to the US government, which is not by brand.
43. Mr Bramley will propose to the next meeting a policy and mechanism for responding to queries, and a central register which will meet the legal constraints of all the Operating Groups
