BELL/LAING

I wrote to you and said that I had no intention of entering a debate with Bell/Laing and I am sending you a copy of my last letter to Mr. Jones. For your own purposes, I am also enclosing R. & D.E. comments on Intertek Report Mark 3.

I do not know whether you would agree with me but I have taken the line that, since we have turned down Bell/Laing, they now become potential competition.
