General information

The symposium 'Effects of Nicotine on Biological Systems' will be held in Hamburg, FRG, June 28-30, 1990, as a satellite meeting of the XIth International Congress of Pharmacology, Amsterdam, July 1-6, 1990. It will cover the pharmacology and toxicology of nicotine. Particular attention will be directed to the effects of nicotine on various organ systems, especially the central nervous system. Behavioural effects will also be dealt with. Aspects of smoking and health will be included in the program only as far as these are related to nicotine.
