"SMOKING BEHAVIOUR STUDIES AT CAMBRIDGE:
A COMPARISON OF MIDDLE-TAR AND LOW-TAR SMOKERS
ON THEIR USUAL BRANDS"

This report contains the detailed results from one of our "Cambridge studies" on smoking behaviour.

We have already given the main findings in a short report (RD.1756 Restricted) which we issued last September. As you will recall, we obtained indicative evidence that smokers of low tar brands ingest a lower quantity of smoke than do smokers of middle-tar brands.

Whilst Philip Short would probably welcome sight of this report, I see no need for a wide circulation of these detailed results.
