

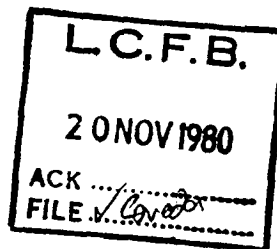

Thank you for your letter of 12th November. I had, as you surmised, already had a chat with Colin Greig and received notes from him. Nevertheless, it was very helpful to receive your comments and I appreciate having advance information on your formal report. I look forward to reading the report with considerable interest.

In the meantime we are using the B. & W. instrument and method. We received some of the B. & W. standards very recently and this will help us check the settings we are using currently. As you will be aware, the results obtained are quite sensitive to the setting and, up to now, we have been working with those that appear to us to be sensible and which show up differences between samples.

At some stage it may be useful to cross-check with yourselves and should you select some "standards" perhaps you would keep us in mind.
