On reflection, I do not believe that the first two stages of their Project are particularly novel and, over the years, many BAT Group Projects have been in this area. However, an enormous amount of research is required if elimination were taken to completion.

By the way, there do seem to be some variations on this Project and my agreement with them is on the assumption that the work is chemically driven rather than biologically driven.

Finally, I do not believe there is any sound basis as yet for the neutralisation hypothesis.
