S Y N T H O S

Mr. Wilkie, via Mr. Stewart Lockhart, has asked me to arrange for Ghana, Nigeria, Angola, and at a later date, Sierra Leone, to carry out experiments with the use of PROTAM as a flavour.

As you know, we have been informed in strict confidence by W. J. Bush & Co., Ltd., the manufacturers of PROTAM that this flavour contains a percentage of SYNTHOS. From the information received, we have calculated that at an application rate of 4 fluid ounces of PROTAM per 100 lbs. of rag, the amount of SYNTHOS conveyed to the blend would be probably not more than .007%.

In view of Mr. Wilkie's instructions, I should be grateful for your guidance as to what action I should now take.
