
Dear Leo,

When we were making the arrangements for Dr. Hook's visit to Canada, I wrote to you to ask if you had any objection to him having discussions with Prof. Beeckmans of the University of Western Ontario. As you had already left, Mr. Keith replied - after consulting with Bob Wade - and pointed out that Beeckmans had approached I.T.Co. in the past for a grant, but that there was no objection to a visit by Dr. Hook.

On his return, Hook has produced a note covering the discussions he had with Beeckmans, and I enclose a copy for your interest. This is an internal File Note and I think you know the restrictions which apply to this type of information. I thought you would be glad to see, however, that the discussions were strictly technical.
