Dear Bob,

Thank you for your letter of the 8th March containing your results for the Dr. Ogg collaborative study; these are most interesting. Concerning the chloride estimate, we used a commercial calomel cell - porous plug type without a salt bridge, as the diffusion of the chloride ion from the electrode is slow. Though we do not use a calomel electrode with our chloride method it worked well in our hands.

As for the potassium results, we were interested to receive a copy of the B. & W. results, which showed the same degree of reproducibility as ourselves.
