R.A.3 DISINTEGRATOR FOR CANADA

We wish to confirm the telephone conversation which took place today between Mr. Ling and the writer concerning the supply of an R.A.3 Scott Rietz disintegrator to the Imperial Tobacco Co. of Canada Ltd.

The quotation should be for a unit generally similar to that supplied on our Order No.19402 with the exception that the motor should be of 60 h.p. and suitable for the supply in Montreal.
