My dear Schreiber,

We have reviewed your very interesting letters, and enclosures, dated October 21 and 22, and are in substantial agreement with your suggestions.

Evers, Laporte and myself have had several preliminary discussions and we have drawn up a complete outline of our present plans, capacities, personnel, etc., and our thoughts for the future.

As you will know by the time you receive this letter, Dr. Tucker is coming to Montreal for two days, November 16 and 17, to allow the three men - Evers, Tucker and Laporte - to reach substantial agreement on the material that should be prepared and on a suggested agenda for the meetings; although, as you realize, all have already done considerable work in this direction. When anything develops from this, I will see that you are apprised of it.

The tentative plans that your London committee have made for Southampton are very interesting and should, when finalized and actually put into operation, be of tremendous value to all of our Companies.

I am sorry that this did not reach you before you left London, but I wanted to wait until the opportunity of some discussions with Evers had presented itself..

I am sure that the results of deliberations that will be carried on here in December will produce a satisfactory report for presentation to our various Companies.
