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Comments without further information on smoke metabolism & kinetics of these types

At the Kronberg Conference it was agreed that I should ask Dr. Nisbet to summarise our thoughts about what were termed 'metabolic competitors', and to circulate the outline to the group for their comments.

The underlying idea is that there may be in smoke, non-toxic compounds which, by becoming involved in the metabolism of the smoker, may produce adverse effects. The accompanying outline deals briefly with the broad classes of compounds which should be considered and touches briefly on how a search for these compounds might be started.

Should the proposal receive general approval, we would propose to start the initial literature survey here and would be grateful if other laboratories could make us aware of any relevant material or references which they come across in the course of their normal reading.
