I am enclosing some notes prepared by Tom Smith following a meeting held in our laboratories on September 12 with Jim Hogg and Peter Witschi. Bilimoria has been on holiday this week but we think the notes are sufficiently accurate to send them to you so that you will be aware that active discussions have started. We will send you another report after the next meeting on September 23 and will try to keep you well informed of future activity. We would like very much to receive any comments and opinions which you might have on any part of our activities.

As you will see when you read the notes the selection of a smoking machine for the exposure of a variety of laboratory animals is of paramount importance. As soon as the project has received approval (or otherwise) from the CTCM we would like to be in a position to order a suitable smoking machine. Preferably this machine should be the same as the ones which you propose using in Southampton. We are wondering if you have made a decision yet about the kind of smoking machine to employ. From our quite limited knowledge we would tend to prefer the Oak Ridge smoking machine but we don't know what you plan to use and also we are not sure of the availability of the Oak Ridge smoker.
