Thank you for your letter of 15th August and for the copy of the memorandum to Mr. Pare. Your summary of the situation was accurate and I do not think that there is any need for further elaboration. The strongest points in favour seem to be those relating to:

- (1) research based in Canada;
- (2) local involvement with the medical fraternity;
- (3) the integration of the Montreal effort towards a common Group objective.

CTMC sponsorship or in-house funding of work is obviously the key question to be decided. For various reasons, August has been a busy month for most of us, and as far as I am aware it has not yet been possible to discuss this particular aspect of the proposed programme.

I am sure Dr. Green will be pleased to be kept up-to-date, and that he will consider the situation in due course.
