Dear Richard,

Thanks for your letter of August 2. I enclose a copy of a note I sent to Mr. Paré. You can judge whether I've got the story right and thus whether you should write a summary of the programme rationale.

Witschi has conferred with his superiors and has indicated that his participation would sit well with his university and with the Canadian Medical Research Council. He has also said that he could probably do enough animal exposure to satisfy our full requirements, but would be agreeable to playing the consultant teaching role, with the main body of work taking place at McGill under Hogg.

Mr. Paré's reaction is that we should prepare a proposal for submission to CTMC by Jim Hogg, but he did not rule out the possibility of doing the work under our own auspices. I felt that Jim Hogg would greatly prefer CTMC sponsorship, and in fact might have difficulty obtaining McGill University approval to work for an individual company. In any event, I think now is the time for you people to indicate your views as regards CTMC sponsorship, and am therefore copying this correspondence to Dr. Green.
