Evaluation of Air Quality in
Montreal Plant

Ref.: Memo from T. Mehes to D. Henry dated December 6, 1982.

In our discussion last week we agreed to eliminate certain test areas from Beak's proposal. We also eliminated all personal and respirable dust monitoring until the preliminary tests identify problem areas. This leaves us with 21 total dust, and 9 nicotine samples over 4 days of testing (including controls). The fee for IEC-Beak's services will now be in the order of \$5100 (see the modified budget proposal appended).

NOTE: The modifications have not been discussed with Beak, but the reduced fee should be fairly accurate.

We believe that any further reduction in the number of test samples would seriously compromise the statistical validity of the entire project.
