re : Projects ERIE and CRAWFORD

During our discussions with you and your team on the above projects, we identified some samples of cigarettes and flavours which we believed would be useful for you to evaluate. The samples identified were:

Cigarettes

- 400 NEWPORT ex - Finland.
- 400 NEW LOOK (Menthol) ex - Finland.
- 200 CONSULATE ex - U.K.
- 100 S134 (100% FT) ex - GRADC.
- 100 S134 (with additional ventilation) ex - GRADC

Flavours

- No.58 with and without Va enhancer.
- Spicy flavours - Cardamon, Dill, Mace, Allspice, Caraway,
EDSTAN.

I understand all the cigarette samples have already been dispatched together with the flavour samples. I hope these have all been safely received.

You had also requested some further details on the Automatic Flavour Injection System. After discussions here, the cost of a unit similar to that in Report T.118 is estimated as approx. £7,000 and the timescale for production would be approx. 2 months from receipt of order.
