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Introduction

The Medical Services Commission under the authority of the *Medicare Protection Act* administers the Medical Services Plan of British Columbia (MSP). The MSP insures registrants for medically required services provided by general practitioners, specialists and other health practitioners. The MSP pays practitioners on a fee-for-service and an alternative payment basis.

The **Physician Resource Report** contains 10 years' statistics on BC physicians, based on the fee-for-service payments they received for providing services to MSP registrants.

Methodological Notes

The data includes Medical Services Plan fee-for-service payments made to general practitioners and specialists, for insured services provided to MSP registrants. Only services performed in a given fiscal year (April 1 to March 31) and paid on or before September 30 of the following year are included.

The Physician Resource Report includes:

- Expenditures paid for by the Medical Services Plan (includes the adjudicated fee schedule amount, retroactive payments, rural retention program payments and tray fees);
- Expenditures paid to physicians for services referred by registered midwives or nurse practitioners;
- Changes under the 2010 Second Renewed Laboratory Agreement – a revised fee schedule implemented on October 1, 2010 and a continuation of the laboratory volume discounting mechanism implemented April 1, 2007;
- Retroactive fee increases paid up to and including September 30, 2011 for 2006/2007 to 2010/2011 medical expenditures;
- Expenditures for temporary H1N1-specific fee items in 2009/2010.

The following are excluded from the Physician Resource Report:

- Payments that practitioners receive for services not covered by MSP, such as those by ICBC and WorkSafe BC;
- Interest on late payment of claims;
- Payments for form fees;
- Payments for General Practice Services Committee and Specialist Services Committee initiatives;

- Services associated with the following service codes as these services are charges in addition to the principal fee:
 - 9 – General Practice Visit Premiums,
 - 19 – No Charge Referral,
 - 29 – Specialist Visit Premiums,
 - 49 – Procedural Premiums, and
 - 71 – Tray Fees;

- Alternative payments made for contract, salaried, session, etc services;

- Payments for services performed out-of-province.

Practitioner Information

Practitioner Information includes data on practitioners who provide services insured by the Medical Services Plan.

The following criteria were applied in addition to those listed in the Methodological Notes section.

Practitioner Counts

Practitioners are counted only once per fiscal year using the following conditions:

1. Only practitioners registered with the MSP of British Columbia are included.
2. Practitioners must have expenditure total greater than 0 (zero) in the fiscal year.
3. Practitioners are assigned one specialty for each fiscal year called a Most Recent Specialty.
4. Total physician count includes physicians with unknown gender.
5. To maintain confidentiality, physician count equal to or less than 5 is replaced by an asterisk.

Practitioner Specialty

Public Health (21) and Occupational Medicine (23) are rolled into General Practice.

Respirology (49) was effective January 2006.

Cardiology (26), Endocrinology (51), Gastroenterology (56), Nephrology (59), Infectious Disease (67) and Hematology Oncology (74) were effective August 2007.

Critical Care Medicine (53) was effective April 2010.

Physicians with these specialties previously billed under Internal Medicine (15).

Days Worked

A day is counted as 'Day Worked' if a practitioner's total payment received for that day is greater than zero.
