Clarification on Claims for Compounded Preparations

Further to this item from the last newsletter 03-02 (February 4, 2003), at this time PharmaCare will be focussing on compounded preparations where a Special Authority (SA) has previously been approved for a commercially available dosage form.

As an example, lansoprazole in suspension would not be automatically eligible for coverage even though the lansoprazole capsules have been approved under a Special Authority request. Other treatment options may be feasible. If a physician and/or pharmacist still wishes to provide the alternative dosage form other than what has been approved and commercially available, the ingredient cost breakdown and details of the compounding fee should be provided to a PharmaCare pharmacist. If the cost is excessive, the request for coverage may be denied. If the compound is approved, an SA will be provided for a compound PIN specific for that patient. Regular PINS are not to be used for this purpose.

PharmaCare is reviewing the larger compound policy issue and will be striking a working group in the near future to discuss this in detail with the intent of developing a more defined/limited compounding policy. If you wish to participate in the working group, please contact suzanne.solven@gems2.gov.bc.ca and identify why you are interested. Please note that participation will be limited.

Since the previous newsletter, telephone requests regarding compounding have escalated. We wish to re-confirm that:

- (a) Non-benefit items compounded together are still not a benefit, e.g. Over-the-Counter products, Special Access Program drugs;
- (b) Compounded preparations to overcome a manufacturer's shortage are not necessarily benefits if other treatment options exist.
- (c) oral drugs compounded for topical use will not be a benefit and SA coverage will not be considered unless identified otherwise with supporting medical literature, e.g. topical diltiazem, topical NSAIDS, topical estrogen, topical narcotics.
