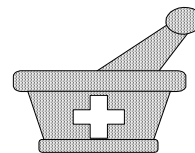

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## Clarification regarding Changes to Coverage of Nasal Corticosteroids Effective November 19, 2001

In the original information release (*Pharmacare Newsletter 01-12*) regarding changes to the Pharmacare benefit list, no specific reference was made to the nasal corticosteroid **triamcinolone** (Nasacort<sup>®</sup>, Nasacort AQ<sup>®</sup>). We regret the omission of this information.

As with the nasal corticosteroids fluticasone and mometasone, **triamcinolone** will no longer be a Pharmacare benefit effective **November 19, 2001**. Pharmacare will provide coverage only for the three least expensive nasal corticosteroids: beclomethasone, budesonide and flunisolide.

This decision is based on a literature review which yielded no conclusive evidence that one nasal corticosteroid is more effective or causes fewer side effects than another in the treatment of Allergic Rhinitis.
